After moving to Siloam Springs, AR Susie served with Meals on Wheels, was an active member of PEO, Entre Nous Women's Fortnightly Club, and a member of Redeemer Presbyterian Church.

A service to celebrate her life will be held at Redeemer Presbyterian Church on Thursday, May 9th at 2:00 pm. A graveside service will be held at Memorial Park Cemetery in Tulsa, OK, on Friday, May 10, 2024, at 2 p.m.
