Margarita Mabel Ancenson Baldonado Lovitt, 82, of Decatur, Arkansas, died May 10, 2026 at the Circle of Life Hospice in Bentonville, AR. She was the second child born on December 17, 1943 in Parks, Nebraska to Meloquias "Max" and Maria M. "Mary" (Maes) Baldonado. As an infant she and her family lived in New Mexico with Spanish being her first language, later they settled in Wauneta Nebraska where she attended school and learned English. During high school she worked at the local drive in and after graduation attended business school in Omaha, NE.

On January 28, 1967, she married Lester "Bud" Lovitt at the St John's Catholic Church in Wauneta, NE and together they shared 59 years of marriage. Before her family moved to Arkansas in 1981, she worked as a CNA at the Community Hospital in McCook, NE and also as head cook at the McCook Community College. After moving to Arkansas, she worked at Dawn Hill Country Club a few years. She was later asked by Mr. Peterson to manage the The House of Chicken in Decatur, AR. From there she became a district manager for Kentucky Fried Chicken and finished her career at Walmart working as a CSM and retired from the mail room at the corporate office in Bentonville.

Huskers. She loved to follow her children and grandchildren to all of their extracurricular activities. She enjoyed traveling to OKC to help with a wedding or special event with the flower shop. 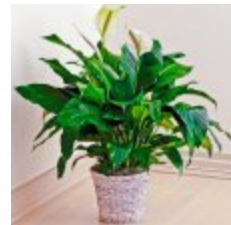
