January 19, 1915 - February 20, 2006

Marion Blagg, 91-year-old resident of Kansas, Oklahoma, died Wednesday, February 22, 2006, in Fayetteville, Arkansas. Born January 19, 1915, in Delaware County, Oklahoma, he was the son of Joe Blagg and Mina Mitchell Blagg. Marion was a lifetime resident of Delaware County, Oklahoma, and farmed all of his life.
