Marsha Lee Oliver, 66, of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, entered into the presence of her Lord Jesus Christ on October 24. Marsha was born on May 28th, 1942, in San Francisco, California to George and Leona Oliver. She grew up in Long Beach, California, was a graduate of Millikan High School, attended Biola University and graduated from Long Beach City College. While she was a California native her heart was always in the big sky country of Montana. Marsha contracted polio at a young age and despite significant disabilities spent many years working for the State of California Department of Employment as a manager and a supervisor. She received numerous awards and citations and was appointed by the Governor to the California State Employment Development Task Force where she served until her retirement. She was preceded in death by her parents, her sister-in-law, Carrie Oliver and her nephew, Matt Oliver. Survivors include her brother, Gary J. Oliver; nephews Nathan Oliver and his wife Amy and daughter Alivia of West Palm Beach, Florida, and Andrew Oliver of Siloam Springs; aunts Norma Jackson of Great Falls, Montana and Cecil Jackson of Dallas, Texas. Marsha loved to travel and to prepare gourmet food but she was most known and loved for her love for the Lord, her family and friends, her sweet smile, her kind, generous and unselfish spirit and her gift of encouragement. Everyone who knew Marsha was inspired by her and felt better after being around her. Marsha was active at Christ Community Fellowship in Siloam Springs.
