Mary Ella Busse, 82 year-old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died November 10, 2005, at Siloam Springs Memorial Hospital, Siloam Springs, Arkansas. Born September 28, 1923, in Red Oak, Iowa, she was the daughter of Emory Dewitt Showalter and Stella Blanche Andrews Showalter.
