Mary Jane Henderson, 64, of Decatur, Arkansas, died on Tuesday, June 2, 2015, at home, surrounded by her family, after an eight year battle with ovarian cancer. She was born on August 7, 1950, in Decatur, Arkansas, to Wayne Meigs and Olga McClellan Meigs. She lived her entire life in Decatur, and in September of 1967, she did the unthinkable-she married a Gentry boy, Dan Henderson.

Mary Jane touched a lot of lives in her 64 years. She was a genuinely good person, and many people loved her.
