



## Michael Edward Jenison

February 25, 1954 - November 7, 2015

Michael Edward “Mike” Jenison, 61, died peacefully in his sleep November 7, 2015. Born February 25, 1954, in Tulsa, OK, he was the son of Gerald Jenison and the late Patricia Donica Jenison. He graduated from Colcord High School and lived most of his life in Siloam Springs, AR and Yukon, OK.
