October 13, 1922 - August 27, 2012

Mina Ruth Robb, 89, longtime resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died August 27, 2012, at Russellville Nursing Center, Russellville, Arkansas. Born October 13, 1922, in Kansas City, Missouri, she was the daughter of John Herbert Shepp and Edna Smith Shepp. She was a kindergarten teacher, and taught in the Siloam Springs Public School prior to her retirement. She married Eldon Robb in Kansas City, Missouri, on November 9, 1943. Mina Ruth was a member of Alpha Delta Kappa, the Koinania Club, PEO Chapter CE, and the United Methodist Women's Group.
