



## Myron Peters

March 10, 1924 - October 22, 2009

Myron J. "Pete" Peters, 85, of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died October 22, 2009 at Circle of Life Hospice, Springdale, Arkansas. Born March 10, 1924 in Albin, Wyoming, he was the son of Henry A. Peters and Clara Garber Peters. He was a World War II Navy Veteran and a 1950 graduate of John Brown University. Pete was a Farm Manager for John Brown University and also worked as a Reference Librarian for John Brown University. He was active in the Siloam Springs Hospital Auxiliary and volunteered at the Manna Center in Siloam Springs. Pete married Hulen Anderson in 1947 in Albin, Wyoming. Pete loved to garden, do woodworking, and play with his grandchildren. He was a member of The First United Methodist Church, Siloam Springs, Arkansas. He was preceded in death by one brother, Marion Peters.
