Nathan Junior Kustanborter, 82, of Colcord, Oklahoma, died November 12, 2013, at Washington Regional Medical Center, Fayetteville, Arkansas. Born November 14, 1930, in Sequoyah Community, Oklahoma, he was the son of Mead Nathan Kustanborter and Opal Mae Burke Kustanborter.
