Norma Lee Wiles, 82 year-old resident of Gentry, Arkansas, died March 26, 2005, at her residence. Born October 12, 1922 in Gentry, Arkansas, she was the daughter of John Albert Taylor and Martha V. Twiggs Taylor. Norma was the wife of former Gentry Mayor, Byron C. Wiles who died in 1993. She had been a defense worker during World War II and was a member of the First Baptist Church, Gentry, Arkansas.
