Norman Brown Saferite, 77, of Siloam Spring, Arkansas, died June 19, 2013, at Washington Regional Medical Center, Fayetteville, Arkansas. Born July 30, 1935, in Clifton, Kansas, he was the son of Roy Charles Saferite and Della Grace Brown Saferite. He was an Army veteran, and received an Associate of Arts Degree from Sonora Junior College, in California. He lived in Nevada prior to moving to Arkansas, where he was a deputy sheriff for Douglas County, and a construction truck driver.
