



Otto "Buddy" Feland Duffield

March 13, 1932 - May 11, 2018

Otto Feland "Buddy" Duffield, 86 year old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died May 11, 2018, at Apple Creek Health and Rehab in Centerton, Arkansas. Born March 13, 1932, in Pawhuska, Oklahoma, he was one of 11 children of Luke Duffield and Corinthia Broaddus Duffield. He grew up in Pawhuska, Oklahoma graduating from Pawhuska High School and lived in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and attended the University of Tulsa. The family then moved to Siloam Springs, Arkansas in 1979. He married Sue Ann Watkins and they were married for 60 years. He was an independent oil producer. Buddy liked to play golf and also enjoyed racing thoroughbred horses. He was a member of Army National Guard # 45 in Pawhuska and St. Mary's Catholic Church, Siloam Springs, Arkansas.

Buddy was preceded in death by wife, daughter Theresa Duffield Evans and son Otto F. Duffield, II.

Survivors include his son James P. 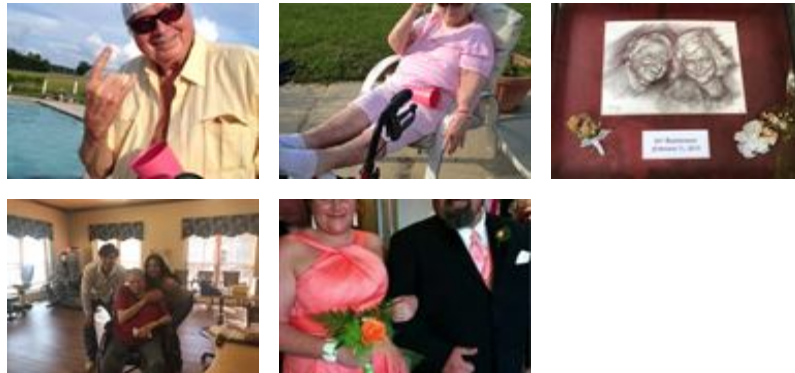
