Otto Feland Duffield, II, 52, of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died June 9, 2011, at W.W. Hastings Indian Hospital, Tahlequah, Oklahoma. Born April 19, 1959, in Pawhuska, Oklahoma, he was the son of Otto Feland Duffield, Sr. and Sue Ann Watkins Duffield. He was a former longtime resident of Siloam Springs and Tulsa, Oklahoma.
