Patrick Shannon Reagan went home to be with Lord at the age of 54 on November 21, 2016 at Northeastern Hospital in Tahlequah, Oklahoma.

Pat was born in Jonesboro, Arkansas on June 21, 1962, the son of Eugene Maurice Reagan, Sr. and Sue Ellen Tate Reagan. He grew up here in Siloam Springs and graduated from Siloam Springs High School in 1980, later attending John Brown University and the University of Arkansas.
