Paul R. Girndt, 93, of Gentry, Arkansas, died January 16, 2014, at Circle of Life Hospice, Springdale, Arkansas. Born September 25, 1920, in Chicago, Illinois, he was the son of Paul Reynold Girndt and Clara Hoby Girndt. He was an Army/Air Force Veteran, having served in World War II, the Korean War, and one tour in Vietnam. He retired from the military in 1969 and moved to Jacksonville, Arkansas. In 1999, he moved to Gentry. He was a life member of the Memphis Lodge #118, and a member of the First Baptist Church in Gentry. He married Gladys Mardell Martin in Southaven, Mississippi, on September 21, 1970.

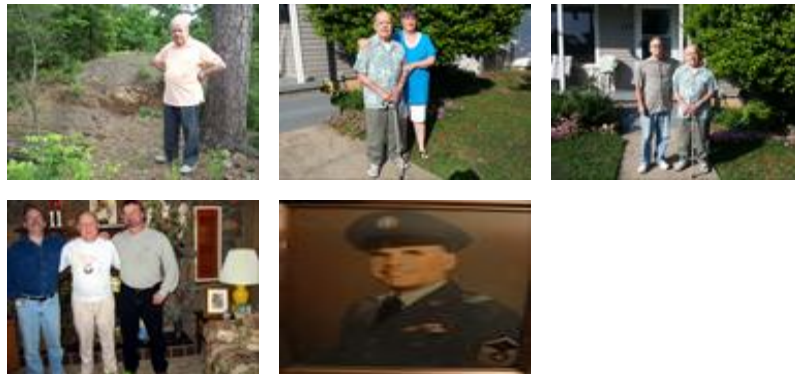
