Peter Jonathan "Pete" Church, 86, of Claremore, Oklahoma, died May 8, 2013, at VA Hospital, Fayetteville, Arkansas. Born January 8, 1927, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, he was the son of Jonathan Church and Rosa Miller Church. Pete was an Air Force Veteran of World War II and the Korean War.
