Raymond Eugene Burch, 81, longtime resident of Twin Oaks, Oklahoma, died on September 20, 2019 at his home in West Siloam Springs, Oklahoma. 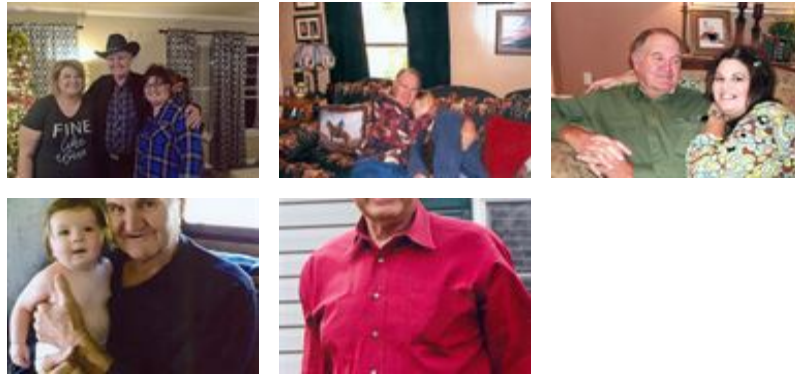
