Rex Lee Allen, 83 year old resident of Colcord, Oklahoma, died August 14, 2017 at his home. Born November 6, 1933 in Delaware County, Oklahoma, he was the son of Albert Lee Allen and Emma Rutherford Allen. Rex married Irene Dee Alexander on May 11, 1955 in Reno, Nevada.
