



## Rick Jenison

June 13, 1955 - May 19, 2008

Richard Allen "Rick" Jenison, 52 of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died May 19, 2008, as a result of injuries sustained in an accident, near Watts, Oklahoma. Born June 13, 1955, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, he was the son of Gerald Arlow Jenison and Patricia Anne Donica Jenison. He was a lifetime resident of Northwest, Arkansas and Northeast, Oklahoma. He graduated from Colcord High School. Rick was owner/operator of Siloam Glass and Mirror in Siloam Springs, and raised horses and cattle on his farm. He married Luann Self on July 25, 1987. Rick was a member of Twin Springs Christian Church, Siloam Springs, Arkansas. He loved spending time outdoors; fishing, riding horses, working on the farm, and floating down the river with his wife and boys. He was loved, respected, and admired by all who knew him. Survivors include his wife Luann of the home; two sons, Kelby Jenison and Corey Jenison, both of the home; his parents Gerald and Pat Jenison of Watts, Oklahoma; two brothers, Mike Jenison and wife Judy and Jerry Pat "Jeep" Jenison and wife Julie, all of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma; one sister, Julianne Stec and husband Steve of Fort Smith, Arkansas; and a number of nieces and nephews. Funeral services will be 2:00 p.m., Friday, May 23, 2008, at Community Christian Fellowship, Siloam Springs, Arkansas, with Tim Estes and Mark Barnett officiating.
