March 3, 1962 - January 26, 2020

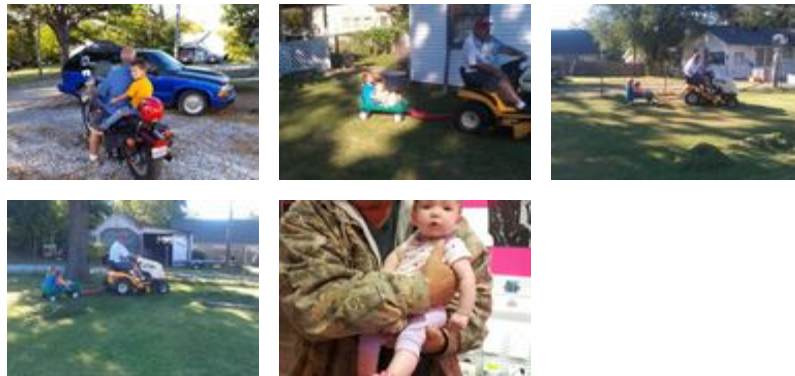
