Robert Lamberson, 86, of Gentry, Arkansas, died Sunday, February 01, 2009, in Siloam Springs, Arkansas. Born June 2, 1922, in Wheaton, Missouri, he was the son of Maurice Vincent Lamberson and Jewell McCall Lamberson. Bob graduated from high school in Bentonville. He lived most of his adult life in Gentry. A World War II veteran of the Army Air Corps, Bob served as a crew chief on a B25 bomber in the South Pacific. He later bought the Gentry Journal Advance newspaper from his father and acted as editor and publisher from 1961-1973. Bob enjoyed golf, hunting, fishing and talking politics. He was preceded in death by a son John Lamberson; brother, Bill Lamberson; and a sister, Maurine Minnehan. Survivors include 2 daughters, Toni Rempe of Siloam Springs, Arkansas; Sherry Ransom and husband Mike of Gentry, Arkansas; 1 grandson, Chris Ransom of Rogers, Arkansas; 1 granddaughter, Jennifer Dortch and husband Keith of Van Buren, Arkansas; 2 great-grandsons; and a brother, Joe Lamberson of Monet, Missouri. A memorial service will be held 10:00 A.M. Friday, February 6, at Wasson Memorial Chapel, Siloam Springs, Arkansas. Inurnment will follow at a later date.
