Robert "Bob" Lee Lynch, Sr., of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died June 2, 2005, at Innisfree Nursing Home, Rogers, Arkansas. Born June 5, 1924 in Commerce, Oklahoma, he was the son of Lee Lynch and Beulah Baker Lynch. He moved to Siloam Springs in 1959 from Neosho, Missouri. Bob was a veteran of World War II, serving in the Marine Corps. He received his B.S. in Vocational Agriculture from Oklahoma State University. He worked as a fieldman for Pet Milk Company for 25 years and for Brand Rex Company for 8 years. He also owned and operated Arkoma Hardware Store and Siloam Pump Company, both in Siloam Springs. He was member of the First Christian Church, Gentry, Arkansas. Bob married Betty Lou Floyd in Miami, Oklahoma on September 17, 1948. He was preceded in death by one sister, Leatha Taylor.
