October 8, 1912 - September 23, 2006

Robert E. "Bob" Sims, 93 year-old former resident of Gentry, Arkansas, died September 23, 2006, in Wills Point, Texas. Born October 8, 1912 in Pampa Texas, he was the son of Will sims and Lula Phippkin Sims. He graduated from Vaughn High School. He married Juanita Robbins in Healing Springs, Arkansas on March 4, 1933. He was a farmer and later retired from Bentonville Arkansas School District in 1978.
