Robert J. Walker, (Bob, Grandbob, or Grandpa), 95, of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, passed away on January 2, 2013, at Circle of Life Hospice, Springdale, Arkansas. Born on January 28, 1917, in Benkelman, Nebraska, he was the son of Harry and Josephine Walker. He graduated from Kansas State in 1940, with a BS Degree in Industrial Chemistry. He was drafted and served five years in the U.S. Army during World War II, and was stationed in the South Pacific. For much of his life, Bob managed paint factories.
