Roberta Elizabeth Hildy, 88 year old resident of Rogers, Arkansas, died on October 4, 2019 at Circle of Life Legacy Village, in Bentonville, Arkansas. Roberta was born on August 25, 1931 in Ravenna, Nebraska, to Robert M. Lee and Elizabeth Moore Lee. She graduated from high school and attended college at Colorado State University in Fort Collins. Roberta graduated from there with a Bachelor's Degree in Fine Arts. Roberta was the Vice President of Alpha Chi Omega sorority and was Sigma Alpha Epsilon sweetheart.
