



## Rondel Holliday

March 13, 1942 - August 8, 2012

Rondel James Holliday, 70, of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died August 8, 2012, at Washington Regional Hospital, Fayetteville, Arkansas. Born March 13, 1942, in Long Beach, California, he was the son of Rondel Elvin Holliday and Julia "Billie" Holliday. He was a 1960 graduate of Siloam Springs High School and graduated from John Brown University with a B. S. degree in chemistry.

He received a M.S. degree in chemistry from the University of California, Berkeley and a Ph.D. in chemical physics from the University of Minnesota.

For 38 years he served at JBU in various roles including Associate Dean, Dean of Faculty, Vice-President for Academic Affairs and Professor. He was a member of the Siloam Springs Rotary Club where he was a past president, Paul Harris Fellow and was currently serving as the club secretary. He was also a member of the Grand Lake Sail Club, Grove, Oklahoma.

He married Marilyn Hood in 1964. He was a member of Sager Creek Community Church, Siloam Springs.

Survivors include his wife Marilyn of the home; one son, Brad Holliday and wife Hyokyung of Kailua Kona, Hawaii; one daughter, Julie Reynolds and husband Buddy of Siloam Springs; four grandchildren; and one sister, Pam Ferguson of Bolivar, Missouri.

Memorial services will be 2:30 p.m., Saturday, August 11, 2012, at Sager Creek Community Church, Siloam Springs. In lieu of flowers, memorial contributions may be made to the John Brown University Jim & Marilyn Holliday Endowed Scholarship.
