Roy Laverne Carter, 86, of Cincinnati, Arkansas, died December 10, 2008, at his home. Born June 21, 1922, in Fort Cobb, Oklahoma, he was the son of Edgar Dalton Carter and Otha Rice Carter. He was an Army Air Corps Veteran of World War II. He was a mechanic for Ford Motor Company and was a farmer.
