

## Roy Gene Mason

Roy Gene Mason, 82 year old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died May 5, 2016 at St. John's Hospital in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma. 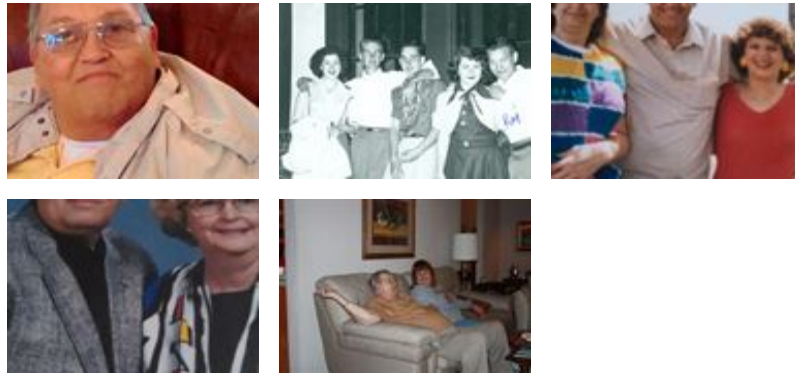
