



## Ruth Reasons

September 16, 1911 - February 3, 2008

Ruth Reasons, 96-year-old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died Saturday February 2, 2008, at Fayetteville City Hospital. Born September 16, 1911, in Decatur, Arkansas, she was the daughter of Roland "Dutch" Rodgers and Mattie Mae Austin Rodgers. Mrs. Reasons grew up in Decatur and graduated from High School there. She was a graduate of Arkansas State Teachers College in Conway. Ruth taught home economics in Decatur for 2 years. She married Doc Reasons May 19, 1934, in Jay, Oklahoma. They moved to Siloam Springs where they raised their daughter Sue and owned and operated Reason's Drug Store in Siloam. Ruth was a member of First Baptist Church in Siloam Springs. She was also active in Northwest Arkansas Cavalcade and the Siloam Springs Riding Club. Ruth was preceded in death by her husband Doc Reasons; daughter, Sue Anglin; sisters, Mary Nell Ruhl and Wanda Lou Grimsley; and brothers, Ray and Joe Rodgers.
