Ray Vaughn Beeman Jr, age 97, passed away peacefully at home in Gentry AR, on June 16, 2023. He was born in 1925 in Brownwood Texas to Ray Vaughn and Gertrude Beeman.

He was preceded in death by his five siblings: Hugh, Fain, Clyde, Nova Dee Beeman Egger, and "J.B" James Bradley.

RV joined the army in 1944 at the age of 19 and served in 2nd Squadron, 5th Cavalry Regiment, 1st Cavalry Division. They were married for 73 years before Betty's passing in Dec 2020. RV worked many jobs through the years from breaking horses in Texas to working on his son's dairy farm until he "retired" at the age of 87. 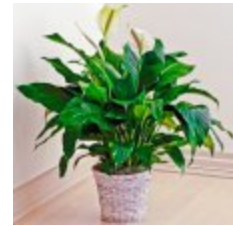
