Sandra Jean Scott, 51 year-old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died February 4, 2008, at Washington Regional Medical Center, Fayetteville, Arkansas. Born January 28, 1957 in Austin, Minnesota, she was the daughter of Edward Hessenius and Margueritte Varney Hessenius. She moved to Siloam Springs from Austin when she was six years old and graduated from Siloam Springs High School in 1975. She married Darrel Scott on November 11, 1973 in Siloam Springs. She was a receptionist for the Siloam Springs Medical Center, now known as the Community Physicians Group. She attended Harvard Avenue Baptist Church, Siloam Springs, and was a member of the Xi Alpha Delta ladies sorority. She was preceded in death by her mother in 2007. Survivors include her husband Darrel of the home; one daughter, Valerie Collinworth and husband Fred of Tulsa, Oklahoma; her dad Ed Hessenius of Siloam Springs, Arkansas; one brother Larry Hessenius of Siloam Springs, Arkansas; and one sister, Linda Henry and husband John of Siloam Springs, Arkansas; and one nephew and four nieces. Funeral services will be 1:00 p.m., Thursday, February 7, 2008, at Wasson Memorial Chapel, Siloam Springs, Arkansas, with Dr. John Terry officiating. There will be a private family interment at Oak Hill Cemetery, Siloam Springs, Arkansas.
