Sheila Faye Holt, 39, of Gentry, Arkansas, died October 4, 2007, as the result of an accident on Highway 412, near Siloam Springs, Arkansas. Born November 16, 1967 in Hamilton, Ohio, she was the daughter of Dearl Dean Peachee and Jeraldine Smith Peachee. She was a mail carrier for the Siloam Springs Postal Service. She married Curtis Lynn Holt on April 6, 1993 in Bentonville, Arkansas. She was a member of Grace Haven Church, Gentry, Arkansas. Survivors include her husband of the home; her parents; one daughter, Shimay Holt of the home; one son, Carter Holt of the home; one brother, Dearl Dewayne Peachee and wife Jerri of Gentry, Arkansas; and one sister, Tammy Lynn Meek and husband Lenny of Decatur, Arkansas. Graveside services will be 10:00 a.m., Tuesday, October 9, 2007, at Dickson Cemetery, near Cherokee City, Arkansas, with Glenn Whitman officiating.
