May 8, 1919 - September 19, 2005

Silas "Jack" Bell, 86-year-old resident of Kiefer, Oklahoma, died Monday, September 19, 2005, in the Veterans Hospital in Fayetteville, Arkansas. Born May 8, 1919, in Haskell, Oklahoma, he was the son of Silas Lafate Bell and Sarah Arizona Bingham Bell. He had been a resident of Colcord, Oklahoma for 30 years and was a former resident of Tulsa. Mr. Bell was a U.S. Army veteran of World War II, and he was a member of the DAV.
