Smythe Monroe Walls, 85 year old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died on March 20, 2019, at his home. 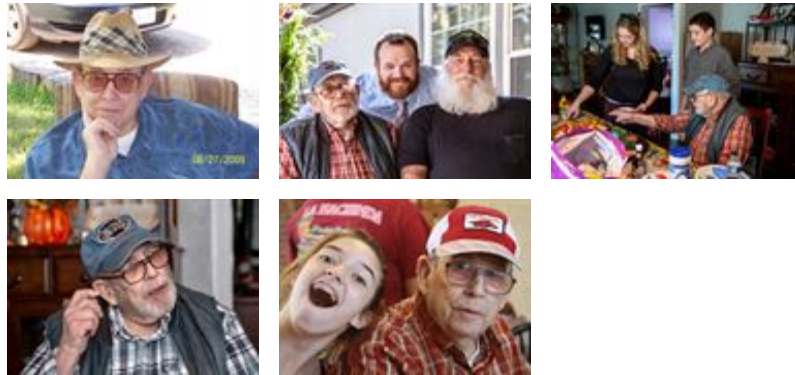
