March 24, 1968 - November 15, 2009

Stacy L. Martin, 41, of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died November 15, 2009, at Siloam Springs Memorial Hospital, Siloam Springs, Arkansas. Born March 24, 1968, in San Jose, California, she was the daughter of Betty Kirkpatrick Smith and Bob Smith. Stacy moved to Siloam Springs in 1976 from California and was a dispatcher and paramedic for the Siloam Springs Police Department. She enjoyed rodeos, and was named Miss Congeniality of the Rodeo of the Ozarks in the 1980's. She was a member of the Parelli Horsemanship Group. On June 17, 1989, Stacy married Jon Martin in Lincoln, Arkansas. She was preceded in death by her grandmother Louise Little.
