Stanley Wayne Porter, 53, of Springdale, Arkansas, died January 12, 2010, at his home. Born May 11, 1956, in Rockford, Illinois, he was the son of Perry O. Porter and Donna Jean Lusk Porter. Stanley was a graduate of Walnut Ridge High School in Walnut Ridge, Arkansas and lived most of his life in the Walnut Ridge area. He moved to Springdale in 1990 where he has worked as a telecommunications specialist with the Arkansas State Police. Stanley was a former Volvo Team Tennis Circuit Member. Survivors include his mother, Donna Porter of Siloam Springs, Arkansas; two brothers, Brad Porter of Paragould, Arkansas and Phillip Porter and wife Leslie of Siloam Springs, Arkansas; his paternal grandmother, Lois Porter of Batesville, Arkansas; and two nephews and two nieces. Funeral services will be 10:00 a.m., Friday, January 15, 2010, at Wasson Memorial Chapel, Siloam Springs, Arkansas, with Chaplain Norman Hamby officiating. Burial will be 1:00 p.m., Saturday, Jan. 16, 2010, at Lebanon Cemetery, near Nelsonville, Arkansas.
