Sue Ann Duffield, 83, of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, passed away June 15, 2015, surrounded by her loving family, at Washington Regional Hospital, Fayetteville, Arkansas. Born June 18, 1931, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, she was the daughter of Frank and Frances (York) Watkins. Sue Ann lived in Oklahoma City, and graduated from Classen High School. 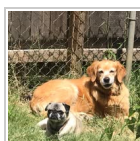
