Glenda Rae “Taddy” DeMont, 87, of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, passed away in Tulsa, OK, after a long battle with cancer.

Born on January 7th, 1939, in Siloam Springs, AR, Taddy was the daughter of the late Glenn W. and Jane Rae (Durham) Black. She graduated from Siloam Springs High School in 1957.

Taddy married her high school sweetheart, Tom DeMont in 1958. Together they raised two children and lived a full life of adventure and love. In 1977 they moved to Germany where Tom was stationed with the U.S. Army. They spent the next 30 years there, traveling and ministering after Tom’s retirement. 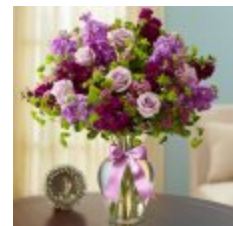
