April 2, 1921 - March 7, 2005

Ted Scott, 83 year-old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died March 7, 2005, at Northwest Medical Center, Springdale, Arkansas. Born April 2, 1921 in Hartford, Michigan, he was the son of Henry S. Scott and Zoa Kidder Scott. Ted was a Navy Veteran of World War II and a former resident of Coldwater, Michigan. He attended Emmanuel Missionary College, a Seventh Day Adventist College, in Berrien Springs, Michigan. In 1983, he retired from the State Hospital in Quincy, Michigan. Shortly thereafter, he moved to Arkansas. He married Gertrude B. Cottman in 1947. Ted enjoyed cooking, traveling, fishing, spending time with his family, and gardening and was well known for his garlic. He was preceded in death by one son, Theodore "Ted" Scott, Jr. Survivors include his wife Gertrude of the home; one daughter, Teresa Regal and husband Jack of Siloam Springs, Arkansas; three grandsons, Scott Regal of Indianapolis, Indiana, Theodore Scott of Springfield, Illinois, and Anthony Scott of Seattle, Washington; two granddaughters, Jacqueline Katsuren of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, and Nichole Frederick of Miamisburg, Ohio; and 6 great grandchildren.
