December 29, 1953 - September 30, 2005

Terry Studards, 51 year-old resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died Friday, September 30, 2005, at Washington Regional Medical Center, in Fayetteville, Arkansas. Born December 29, 1953, in Humboldt, Tennessee, he was the son of William A. Studards and Rubye Mason Studards. He lived most of his life in Siloam Springs and worked at Franklin Electric for 27 years. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Siloam Springs. He married Wenona Mae Gann in 1973 in Siloam Springs. He was preceded in death by a half-brother, Charles Ed Studards, and his parents. Survivors include his wife Wenona of the home; two sons, Derek and Alex Studards of the home; one brother, Bill Studards of Siloam Springs; two half-brothers, William A.
