Tom attended Coates School in Spavinaw. He later attended Tulsa Central High School graduating in 1936. He attended Tulsa Business College graduating in 1937. He was a World War II Veteran of the Army Air Corp. Tom managed a DX Service Station located at Boston and 18th Street in Tulsa for 30 years. He kept in touch with many of his customers through out his lifetime. He was a member of the Oil Capitol Rod and Gun Club where he helped design and build an archery range. He served as President of the Club in 1970. He moved back to the family farm near Cherokee City in 1980 and ranched on the Allen Family Farm, which has been owned by the Allen family for over 100 years. He is survived by his wife, Marie Elliott French Allen; one son-in-law, Ted Marsh, of Tulsa, Oklahoma; one grandson, Scott Marsh of Tulsa, Oklahoma; a great grandson, Collin Marsh of Tulsa, Oklahoma; one brother, Sam B. Allen of Ft. Smith, Arkansas; and many nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his daughter Mariann Marsh. Graveside services will be 2:00 p.m., Saturday, July 5, 2008, at Dickson cemetery, near Cherokee City, Arkansas, with Mr. Jim Whisenant officiating.
