



## Thomas Wayne Jackson

January 5, 1950 - May 1, 2023

Thomas Wayne Jackson, 73, of Kansas, Oklahoma, died May 1, 2023, in Fayetteville, Arkansas. He was born January 5, 1950, in Loveland, Colorado, to Roscoe Roy Jackson and Wauneeta (Sloan) Jackson. When Tommy graduated high school, he was drafted into the United States Army, and was sent to war. He proudly served his country in the Vietnam War from 1969 to 1971. When he returned, he lived in Kansas, Oklahoma, where he resided for the remainder of his life. On August 31, 1985, Tommy married the love of his life, Margie Harrington; they were married 37 years. Tommy enjoyed hunting and fishing in his free time.

He is preceded in death by both parents; one brother, Roy Jackson Jr.; and his only child, Kyisha Chanell Reding.

Thomas is survived by his wife, Margie, of the home; one brother, Ray Dean Jackson and wife Judy, of Kansas, Ok.; and one sister, Connie Jackson, of Kansas, Ok.
