Thomas Eugene Odle, 88, of Kansas, Oklahoma, died January 2, 2012, at Siloam Springs, Memorial Hospital, Siloam Springs, Arkansas. Born December 15, 1923, in Locust Grove, Oklahoma, he was the son of Clyde Clarence Odle and Leona Agnes Burgess Odle. He lived most of his life in the Bull Hollow area near Kansas where he raised cattle and cut wood. He was a Navy veteran of World War II. He was a member of the Kansas American Legion and VFW. He worked for Midwest Marble and Tile as a tile mechanic out of Tulsa. Tom married Margaret Gayle Heckart in December, 1962, in Kansas, Oklahoma.
