Troy Randall Ennis, 61, of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died March 28, 2012, at Siloam Springs Memorial Hospital. Born June 6, 1950, in Stockton, California, he was the son of James Ennis and Mae Reaves Ennis. He lived most of his life in the Northwest Arkansas area and was a graduate of Gentry High School.
