Troy Allen Fields, 79, of Siloam Springs died Saturday, Jan. 7, 2006. He was born May 9, 1926, in the Rogers area to Clarence and Allie (Pollack) Fields. He was a veteran of World War II, serving in the Philippines and receiving a Purple Heart. He was an artist, tinsmith, musician, songwriter, recording artist, entrepreneur, builder and cook. His favorite music was bluegrass, and he often played music with his brothers. After retiring, he returned to painting and developed a unique style of colored marker paintings of the old days in the hills of Arkansas. He was preceded in death by one brother, Fred Fields; and one sister Dorothy Scott. Survivors include his wife, Mary of the home; two sons, Gary and LaVaughn "Von"; a daughter, Troiella; two sisters, Alice Graves and Leona Fields, both of Rogers; three brothers, John Fields of Bentonville and Ralph Fields and Leonard Fields, both of Rogers; six grandchildren; and five great grandchildren.
