Truman Edward Morgan, 73 year-old resident of Gentry, Arkansas, died February 26, 2007 at Quail Ridge Living Center. Born October 12, 1933 in Hallet, Oklahoma, he was the son of Harry and Gladys Bailey Morgan. Truman married Kathryn A. Norton in Kansas City, MO on April 21, 1957.
