Survivors include her son Rick Walburn of Bella Vista, Arkansas and niece Shannon Davis and husband Jeff of Centerton, Arkansas.

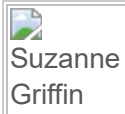
A private graveside service will be held at Oak Hill Cemetery, Siloam Springs, Arkansas.
