Walter Judd, 89, of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died Saturday, November 8, 2008, at Siloam Springs Nursing and Rehab. Born August 29, 1919 in Seattle, Washington, he was the son of William Judd and Ethel Maude Edmison Judd. He was an Army Veteran of World War II. He was shipped to England on the Queen Mary along with 18,000 other young men and served in Patton's 3rd Division. He was a buyer for Boeing Aircraft. He was formerly from Sedalia, Missouri, and Huntsville, Alabama, and moved to Siloam Springs in 1982. Walter was a member of the Arkhoma Whirlaways, the American Legion and the VFW. Walter was a member of First Christian Church, Siloam Springs, Arkansas. He married Anita Staggs Wrenn on May 4, 1978 in Sedalia, Missouri. He was preceded in death by one son and three brothers. Survivors include his wife Anita of the home; one stepson Danny L. Wrenn of Yuma, Arizona; and a number of nieces and nephews including Walter Judd and wife Betty of Minnesota and Sally Close and husband Dennis of Chicago, Illinois. Funeral services will be 10:30 a.m., Wednesday, November 12, 2008, at First Christian Church, Siloam Springs, Arkansas, with Pastor Jason Murray officiating. Burial will follow at Oak Hill Cemetery, Siloam Springs, Arkansas. Public viewing will be 2:00 to 8:00 p.m., Tuesday, November 11, 2008, at Wasson Funeral Home, Siloam Springs, Arkansas.
