Walter Otis Woodruff, 79, lifelong resident of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, died January 22, 2009, at his home in Pleasant Springs Assisted Living Center, West Siloam Springs, Oklahoma. Born March 5, 1929, in Lowell, Arkansas, he was the son of Glen Woodruff and Margaret Blaylock Woodruff.
